Submit the Application Form & Receive the Initial Set



Fill out the designated application form and submit it to the hospital window. The service can be used from the day you apply.

Use the Hospitalization Set

Daily necessities are available as needed.

Changing / Stopping the Set

If you wish to change or stop the set during hospitalization, please inform the hospital.

Hospitalization set fees are charged on a daily-rate basis.

- During the set usage period, rental charges are incurred based on the number of days used, regardless of whether individual items are used or how many are used.
- The billing period is counted from the service start date through the discharge date, including morning discharge.

Payment Method for the Hospitalization Set Fee

Please pay the fee at a convenience store or post office counter.

- A payment slip is enclosed with the invoice.
- After receiving the invoice, please pay by the due date at a convenience store or post office counter.

Invoices are closed at the end of each month and mailed around the middle of the following month to the invoice mailing address written on the application form.

If the service is used across multiple months, invoices are issued monthly.

This payment is separate from hospital charges.

Payment cannot be made at the hospital desk.

Personal information obtained by our company will be strictly managed and used only for this service. If necessary to provide the service, all or part of operations may be outsourced to a subcontractor. In such cases, personal information may be shared, managed, stored, and used under our responsibility.

What is the hospitalization set service?
It lets you rent clothing, towels, and daily necessities needed during hospitalization on a daily basis.

Reduces the burden of purchasing daily necessities needed at admission.

We prepare clothing, towels, and daily necessities needed for urgent admission. It also reduces the preparation burden for people living alone and elderly patients.

Reduces the burden on family members to take laundry home.

There is no need to take clothing or towels brought from home back for washing. This reduces the burden of carrying laundry between the hospital and home.

Reduces the patient's emotional burden.

Because family members do not need to replenish daily necessities, patients can focus on treatment with peace of mind.

Provides clean, reliable products through sterilization, disinfection, and washing.

All used clothing and towels are sterilized at high temperature at the laundry facility, so you can always use clean, reliable products.

363 yen (tax excl.)



- During the contract period, fees are billed based on days used, regardless of the number of items used.
- Usage days are counted continuously during the usage period, excluding overnight stays away from the hospital.

- Billing is calculated as daily unit price (tax excluded) x days used plus 10% consumption tax.
